Accordingly, it is mandatory for all students to undergo the COVID-19 PCR Test. The test should be done not more than 96 hours prior to attending the Orientation Program on-campus. The test result should be mailed in advance to your respective college office (*Kindly click to access email ID of college offices*). Only students with "Negative" test result will be allowed entry into the Thumbay Medicity campus. Students are also required to download the ALHOSN UAE Application in your mobiles.

Please note that the Orientation Program is **for students only,** and parents are not allowed to attend due to the extraordinary circumstance of the pandemic prevailing now. Parents/Guardians will be required to drop their ward off at the campus main gate.

Again, as a safety precaution, sharing of devices like laptops or tablets is strictly prohibited in the university. Therefore, it is **mandatory** for all students to **Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)** from the day of orientation.
