



Procedure for Covid19 Treatment For GMU Faculty and Students

What is to be done if a student shows symptoms of COVID19?

- All Students/ Faculty shall undergo thermal scanning at all entry points.
- Any students/ Faculty found to have body temperature more than 37.5 deg C or any symptoms like cold, cough, running nose and body ache should call the **hotline number +97167030677**.
- The details of the reported case/caller (name, college/program, year of study, location, contact number) are collected by Ms. Amna Ihsan, Contact Centre Representative during routine hours. After routine hours, the hotline number will be attended by the Emergency Department, Thumbay Hospital Ajman.
- The College/Department is immediately informed.
- The Emergency Department at Thumbay Hospital Ajman is alerted about the index case.
- Arrangements are made for the student/faculty to go to the Emergency department of the Thumbay Hospital Ajman by their own vehicle or by ambulance, if required.
- The Student /Faculty shall register at the Emergency Department, Thumbay Hospital Ajman.
- Basic investigation like CBC, CRP & Chest X-ray will be carried out as per the MOH Guideline
- PCR Swab will be collected and sent for Covid testing.
- Based on clinical assessment, Students / Faculty will be admitted in respective bed category /ICU facilities will be provided as per symptoms (Mild, moderate & sever category)

- Investigation Request or Admission request will be sent to insurance department for approval
- Self-payment billing details will be requested to the concern authority of GMU for approval and student, faculty can be admitted in separate unit assigned for Covid Management.
- Dr Fiaz Ahamed, Infection Control Physician can be reached on 0522171557, call centre: 067463333, for infection control counselling and he will check the History of contacted persons and shall request them to go for PCR screening facility unit based in Thumbay Hospital Ajman.
- The college fills the Covid Screening Form and submits to the Vice Chancellor Academics.
- Colleges will follow-up on the welfare of the index case on a regular basis and also appropriately advise the contacts to follow the protocol.
- Vice Chancellor Academics submits a daily survey report to the Ministry of Education.
