We are proud of you. Congratulations!!



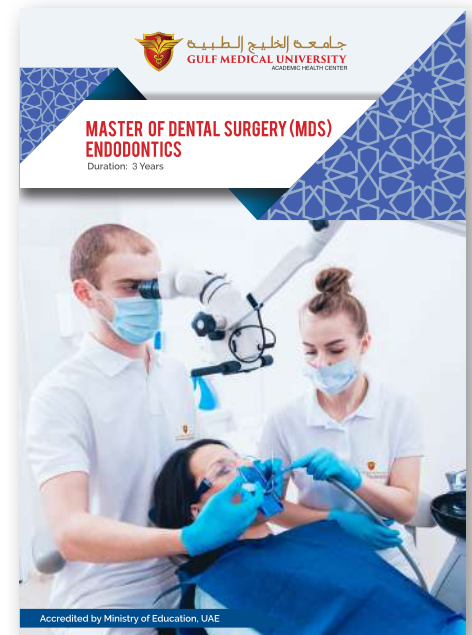
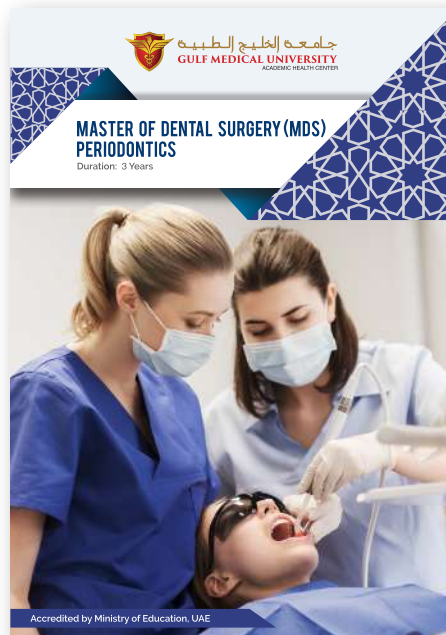
