PROGRAM SUMMARY

The MHPE program aims to empower individuals with the knowledge, skills, and attitudes necessary to become effective educators in the health professions. MHPE students are expected to learn key educational theories principles, instructional design, assessment and evaluation techniques, and leadership skills necessary to improve the quality of health professions education at this context. Graduates of this program will be able to apply their learning to design and deliver effective educational curricula, evaluate the effectiveness of educational interventions, and contribute to the development of educational policy and practice in the field of healthcare. It's a blended program with a mix of webinars and face-to-face bootcamps at GMU. The MHPE program includes an applied project and a thesis as the capstone requirement for graduation.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT

- Graduate of health professions education with a recognized.
 Baccalaureate degree minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or its established equivalent.
- Minimum 2 years of professional experience.
- Proficiency in spoken and written English: TOEFL: Score of 79 on the iBT or 550 PBT (web-based) test or higher. IELTS: Overall score of 6 is required, with no less than 5 on any individual band or module.
